#### MMC Single Board Minutes - August 20, 2024 6:00 P.M. - Wesley Hall

**Present:** Jean Gross, Beth Mueller, Bruce Nodurft, Mark Reth, Charlie Dighton, Wayne Birkenholz, Shirley Davis, Sherry Goranson, Lori Snyder, Pastor Phil.

Mark opened the meeting with scripture from Psalms 71:6 followed by a few comments. Prayers and praises were lifted up followed by a prayer for guidance from Mark.

**Finance:** Bruce shared that our expenses Year-to-Date are \$142,289 and our actual income was \$128,284 leaving a shortfall of -\$14,005. The shortfall is being made up by the final SCRIP monies which is a one time donation of cash to our budget. Our connectional giving to the GMC of \$591/mo. is up to date.

**Trustees:** No meeting was held in July. The work on moving the offices is progressing. This project will be completed this year. Several have expressed concern about the safety issues involving the back steps and have encouraged us to pursue building a ramp to the back door. Options need to be explored and input is needed.

**Worship:** September 8 will be Sunday School kick-off with a potluck and bouncy house and games in Central Park after the nine o'clock service. Two services will resume on September 15 at 8:30 and 10:30.

**Missions:** Wayne reported that around 300 meals including carry-outs were served at the Ice Cream Social with about \$1300 generated after expenses were paid. Proceeds have not been designated at this time. August/Sept. mission of the month is *Pay it Forward*. The Garden of Hope is producing well. Missions is looking at a Soup Supper possibly in January and changing it to a Wednesday evening. Another pancake breakfast for this fall is in the works.

**Reaching and Receiving:** Lori reported the pictorial directory is coming along well with the final pictures to be taken on August 31. People are encouraged to share pictures for the directory that will be published. October 19 an ecumenical worship service will be held at the Pumpkin Patch from 6-8 p.m. All are invited to attend. October 27 is the date for their Trunk or Treat.

**Congregational Care:** October 10th is scheduled for our 80+ birthday party at noon. We will be having the same menu as last year. Ray Wycoff's funeral will be this Saturday. Birthday and anniversary cards have been sent. Marlene visited the GNH and the Meadows. Sherry has made phone calls and visits to shut-ins.

Our next regularly scheduled meeting will be Tuesday, September 17 at 6:00 p.m. in Wesley Hall. Meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m. followed by the Lord's Prayer and singing of the doxology.


